Gen.8: 22 While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

Gen.15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came unto Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield, and thy exceeding great reward.

Deut.6:10-11 (10) And it shall be, when the LORD thy God shall have brought thee into the land which he sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give thee great and goodly cities, which thou buildedst not, (11) And houses full of all good things, which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;

Deut.8:18 But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

Deut.28:2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

Deut.28: 12 The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

Deut.29:9 Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that ye may prosper in all that ye do.

Josh.1:7 Only be thou strong and very courageous, that thou mayest observe to do according to all the law, which Moses my servant commanded thee: turn not from it to the right hand or to the left, that thou mayest prosper whithersoever thou goest.

Josh.1: 8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success.

1Chr.29:11-12 (11) Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. (12) Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all.

2Chr.26:5 And he sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper.

2Chr.31:21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, and in the law, and in the commandments, to seek his God, he did it with all his heart, and prospered.

Job 22:28 Whatever you decide to do will be accomplished, and light will shine on the road ahead of you. (NLT)

Psa.1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Psa.21:2 For you have given him his heart's desire; you have held back nothing that he requested. (NLT)

Psa.23:1 The LORD is my shepherd; I have everything I need. (NLT)

Psa.25:12-13 (12) What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. (13) His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.

Psa.30:6 And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved.:

Psa.35: 27 Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.

Psa.37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.:

Psa.37: 25 I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

Psa.57:2 I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performeth all things for me.

Psa.68:19 Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation.

Psa.105:37 He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.

Psa.107:37 They sow their fields, plant their vineyards, and harvest their bumper crops. (NLT)

Psa.112:1,3 Praise the Lord! Hallelujah! Blessed, happy, fortunate, to be envied is the man who fears (reveres and worships) the Lord, who delights greatly in His commandments. (3) Prosperity and welfare are in his house. (Amp)

Psa.118:25 Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.

Psa.122:6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee.

Psa.127:6 They weep as they go to plant their seed, but they sing as they return with the harvest. (NLT)

Pro.3:9 Honor the LORD with your wealth and with the best part of everything your land produces.(10) Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with the finest wine. (NLT)

Pro.8:21 Those who love me inherit wealth, for I fill their treasuries. (NLT)

Pro.10:4 He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.

Pro.10:22 The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it.

Pro.11:24 It is possible to give freely and become more wealthy, but those who are stingy will lose everything. (25) The generous prosper and are satisfied; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed. (NLT)

Pro.13:22 Good people leave an inheritance to their grandchildren, but the sinner's wealth passes to the godly. (NLT)

Pro.22:4 The reward of humility and the reverent and worshipful fear of the Lord is riches and honor and life. (AMP)

Pro.28:20 A faithful man shall abound with blessings.

Eccl.2:26 For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God.

Eccl.11: 4 He that observeth the wind shall not sow; and he that regardeth the clouds shall not reap.

Isa.45:3 And I will give you treasures hidden in the darkness--secret riches. I will do this so you may know that I am the LORD, the God of Israel, the one who calls you by name.

Isa.48:17 Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go. (NLT)

Isa.54: 17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.

Isa.60:5 Your eyes will shine, and your hearts will thrill with joy, for merchants from around the world will come to you. They will bring you the wealth of many lands. (NLT)

Isa.65:24 I will answer them before they even call to me. While they are still talking to me about their needs, I will go ahead and answer their prayers! (NLT)

Jer.32:17 Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee.

Jer.32:27 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh: is there any thing too hard for me?

Jer.33:3 Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not.

Mat.6:25-34 (25) "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes? (26) Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? (27) Who of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life ? (28) "And why do you worry about clothes? See how the lilies of the field grow. They do not labor or spin. (29) Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. (30) If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? (31) So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' (32) For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. (33) But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. (34) Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own. (NLT)

Mat.7:7-8 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: (8) For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Mat.7:11 If you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give good gifts to those who ask him. (NLT)

Mark 9:23 If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

Luke 6:38 If you give, you will receive. Your gift will return to you in full measure, pressed down, shaken together to make room for more, and running over. Whatever measure you use in giving--large or small--it will be used to measure what is given back to you." (NLT)

Luke 12:32 "So don't be afraid, little flock. For it gives your Father great happiness to give you the Kingdom. (NLT)

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

John 10:10 A thief is only there to steal and kill and destroy. I came so they can have real and eternal life, more and better life than they ever dreamed of. (Message)

John 14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

Rom.8:17 And since we are his children, we will share his treasures--for everything God gives to his Son, Christ, is ours, too. (NLT)

Rom.8:31-32 (31) What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? (32) He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Rom.8:37 No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us. (NLT)

1Cor.1:9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

1Cor.15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2Cor.1:20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. (NIV)

2Cor.2:14 Now thanks be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

2Cor.5:7 For we walk by faith and not by sight.

2Cor.6:2 For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

2Cor.8:9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

2Cor.8:12 If you are really eager to give, it isn't important how much you are able to give. God wants you to give what you have, not what you don't have. (NLT)

2Cor.9:6 But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully.

2Cor.9:8 And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others. (NLT)

2Cor.9:10 Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness.

Gal.3:13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.

Gal.6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Gal.6:9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Phil.1:11 Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.

Phil.4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Col.1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light.

2Tim.2:13 if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself. (NIV)

Heb.6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

Heb.11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb.13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
