12Therefore, since we have such hope, we use great boldness of speech—
13unlike Moses, *who* put a veil over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was passing away. **14**But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the *veil* is taken away in Christ. **15**But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. **16**Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. **17**Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty. **18**But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as **[b]**by the Spirit of the Lord.

1And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples **2**he said to them, “Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” So they said to him, “We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit.” **3**And he said to them, “Into what then were you baptized?” So they said, “Into John’s (WATER) baptism.” **4**Then Paul said, “John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.” **5**When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. **6**And when Paul had laid hands on

them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. **7**Now the men were about twelve in all.

Luke 11:9-13

9“So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. **10**For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. **11**If a son asks for [e]bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if *he asks* for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? **12**Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? **13**If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!”

1Peter 2:4-10 **4**Coming to Him *as to* a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God *and* precious, **5**you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. **6**Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture,

“Behold, I lay in Zion
A chief cornerstone, elect, precious,
And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame.” **7**Therefore, to you who believe, *He is* precious; but to those who **[b]**are disobedient,

“The stone which the builders rejected
Has become the chief cornerstone,” **8**and

“A stone of stumbling
And a rock of offense.” They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed. **9**But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; **10**who once *were* not a people but *are* now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

Jesus is the High Priest and has given you _____to represent Him
Hebrews 9:11 **11**But Christ came *as* High Priest of the good things [c]to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

This gives you authority to mediate on his behalf the kingdom to others.
Hebrews 9:15 **15**And for this reason He is the Mediator of the new covenant, by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions under the first covenant, that those who are called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

-Authority to forgive sins

-Jesus ministry heals the lame man by forgiving sin Mark 2:1-12

1And again He entered Capernaum after *some* days, and it was heard that He was in the house. **2**[a]Immediately many gathered together, so that there was no longer room to receive *them*, not even near the door. And He preached the word to them. **3**Then they came to Him, bringing a paralytic who was carried by four *men*. **4**And when they could not come near Him because of the crowd, they uncovered the roof where He was. So when they had broken through, they let down the bed on which the paralytic was lying.

5When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “**Son, your sins are forgiven you.**”

6And some of the scribes were sitting there and reasoning in their hearts, **7**“Why does this *Man* speak blasphemies like this? Who can forgive sins but God alone?”

8But immediately, when Jesus perceived in His spirit that they reasoned thus within themselves, He said to them, “**Why do you reason about these things in your hearts?** **9**Which is easier, to say to the paralytic, ‘*Your sins are forgiven you,*’ or to say, ‘*Arise, take up your bed and walk?*’ **10**But that you may know that the Son of Man has [b]power on earth to forgive sins”—He said to the

paralytic, **11**“I say to you, arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” **12**Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorified God, saying, “We never saw *anything* like this!”

John 20:23-Forgiveness or retaining sins

23If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the *sins* of any, they are retained.”

Leviticus-Scapegoat =Forgiveness or sending away of sin Leviticus 16:2-22

1Now the Lord spoke to Moses after the death of the two sons of Aaron, when they offered *profane fire* before the Lord, and died; **2**and the Lord said to Moses: “Tell Aaron your brother not to come at *just* any time into the Holy *Place* inside the veil, before the mercy seat which *is* on the ark, lest he die; for I will appear in the cloud above the mercy seat.

3[a]“Thus Aaron shall come into the Holy *Place*: with *the blood of* a young bull as a sin offering, and *of* a ram as a burnt offering. **4**He shall put the holy linen tunic and the linen trousers on his body; he shall be girded with a linen sash, and with the linen turban he shall be attired. These *are* holy garments. Therefore he shall wash his body in water, and put them on. **5**And he shall take from the congregation of the children of Israel two kids of the goats as a sin offering, and one ram as a burnt offering.

6“Aaron shall offer the bull as a sin offering, which *is* for himself, and make atonement for himself and for his house. **7**He shall take the two goats and present them before the Lord *at* the door of the tabernacle of meeting. **8**Then Aaron shall cast lots for the two goats: one lot for the Lord and the other lot for the scapegoat. **9**And Aaron shall bring the goat on which the Lord’s lot fell, and offer it *as* a sin offering. **10**But the goat on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat shall be presented alive before the Lord, to make atonement upon it, *and* to let it go as the scapegoat into the wilderness.

11“And Aaron shall bring the bull of the sin offering, which is for himself, and make atonement for himself and for his house, and shall kill the bull as the sin offering which *is* for himself. **12**Then he shall take a censer full of burning coals of fire from the altar before the Lord, with his hands full of sweet incense beaten fine, and bring *it* inside the veil. **13**And he shall put the incense on the fire before the Lord, that the cloud of incense may cover the mercy seat that *is* on the Testimony, lest he die. **14**He shall take some of the blood of the bull and sprinkle *it* with his finger on the mercy seat on the east *side*; and before the mercy seat he shall sprinkle some of the blood with his finger seven times.

15“Then he shall kill the goat of the sin offering, which *is* for the people, bring its blood inside the veil, do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and before the mercy seat. **16**So he shall make atonement for the Holy *Place*, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions, for all their sins; and so he shall do for the tabernacle of meeting which remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness. **17**There shall be no man in the tabernacle of meeting when he goes in to make atonement in the Holy *Place*, until he comes out, that he may make atonement for himself, for his household, and for all the assembly of Israel. **18**And he shall go out to the altar that *is* before the Lord, and make atonement for it, and shall take some of the blood of the bull and some of the blood of the goat, and put it on the horns of the altar all around. **19**Then he shall sprinkle some of the blood on it with his finger seven times, cleanse it, and consecrate **[b]** it from the **[c]**uncleanness of the children of Israel.

20“And when he has made an end of atoning for the Holy *Place*, the tabernacle of meeting, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat. **21**Aaron shall lay both his hands on the head of the live goat, confess over it all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions, concerning all their sins, putting them on the head of the goat, and shall send *it* away into the wilderness by the hand of a suitable man. **22**The goat **[d]**shall bear on itself all their iniquities to an **[e]**uninhabited land; and he shall release the goat in the wilderness.

1Now the Lord called to Moses, and spoke to him from the tabernacle of meeting, saying, **2**“Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: ‘When any one of you brings an offering to the Lord, you shall bring your offering of the livestock—of the herd and of the flock.

3‘If his offering *is* a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish; he shall offer it of his own free will at the door of the tabernacle of meeting before the Lord. **4**Then he shall put his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him. **5**He shall kill the bull before the Lord; and the priests, Aaron’s sons, shall bring the blood and sprinkle the blood all around on the altar that *is by* the door of the tabernacle of meeting

17Then he shall split it at its wings, *but* shall not divide *it* completely; and the priest shall burn it on the altar, on the wood that *is* on the fire. It *is* a burnt sacrifice, an offering made by fire, a [c]sweet aroma to the Lord.
